Your title XXI Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) state plan amendment (SPA), TX-22-0001, submitted November 10, 2022 has been approved. Through this SPA, Texas reduces copayments for brand name insulin from \$35 to \$25 for all CHIP members with family income above 151 percent of the federal poverty level (FPL) up to and including 201 percent of the FPL. This SPA has an effective date of January 1, 2023.
