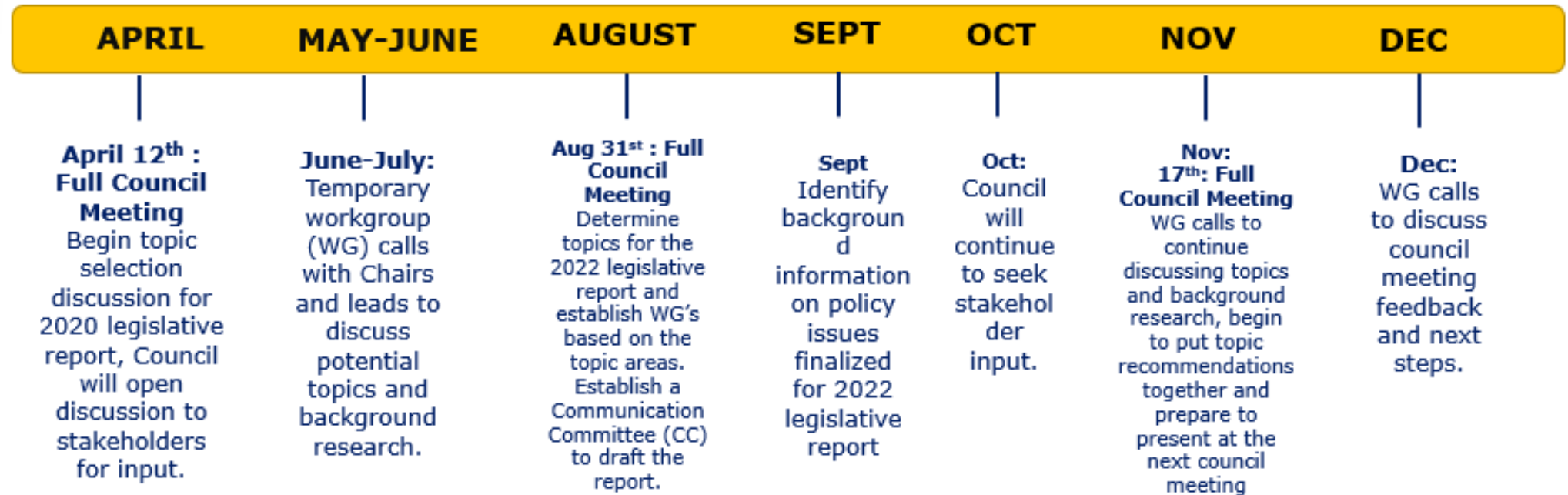

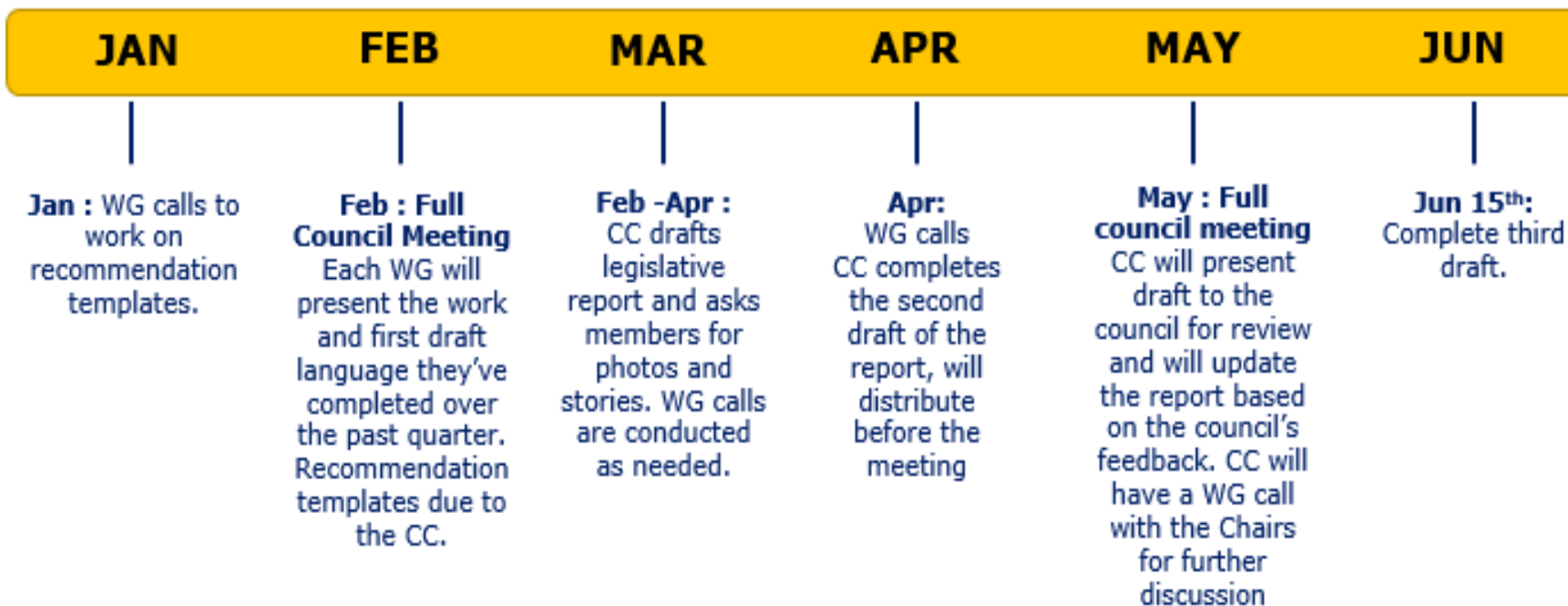


PCCF Legislative Report Timeline (2 of 3)

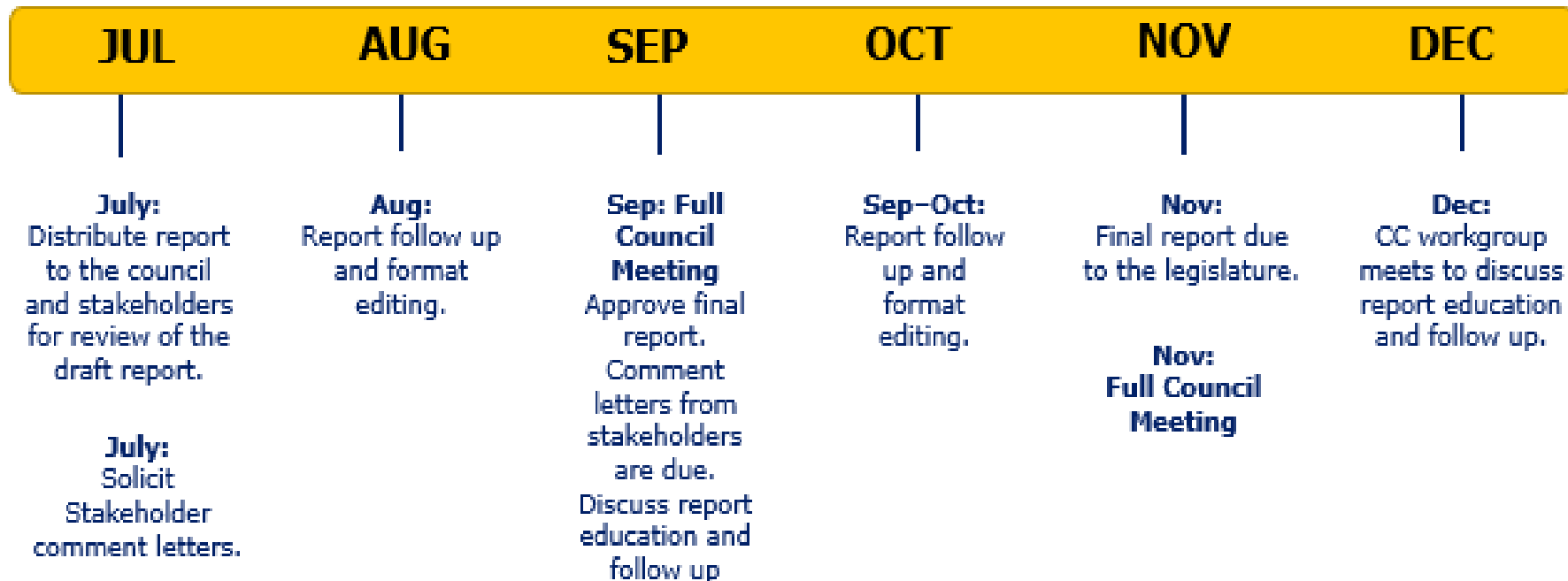


PCCF Legislative Report Timeline (3 of 3)
