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Dear Texas Medicaid Hospitals & Health Plans:

This letter concerns the hospital quality-based Potentially Preventable Readmissions (PPRs) and Potentially Preventable Complications (PPC) program. Specifically, new mid-year hospital-level reports.

Hospitals have requested interim PPR and PPC data in addition to the annual hospital-level reports. This is the first year that the Texas Health and Human Services will provide them. It will include six months of data for state fiscal year 2017 with a three month data lag. It is important to note that this mid-year report is NOT associated with reimbursement adjustments and only for quality improvement information purposes only.

The annual report that includes the full fiscal year 2017 data that is associated with reimbursement reductions will be available in summer 2018.

*Reporting Period:* First Half of Fiscal Year 2017 (September 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017)

*Date available:* August 1, 2017
