NEW DOCUMENTS TO PROVE IDENTITY FOR FINGERPRINTING

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) has created a list of acceptable documents applicants must provide to the enrollment officer when attending a fingerprinting appointment for FAST. The applicant can choose one of the following documents to provide proof of identity:

- Driver's License issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- Commercial Driver's License issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S
- Driver's License PERMIT issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- Commercial Driver's License PERMIT issued by a State or outlying possession of the U.S.
- State ID Card (or outlying possession of the U.S.) with a seal or logo from a State or State Agency
- Federal ID Card with a seal or logo from a Federal Agency
- Passport Book or Card
- Permanent Resident Card / Green Card (I-551)
- Enhanced Tribal ID Cards
- Foreign Passports
- Temporary Paper Licenses issued by Texas
- Temporary Paper ID issued by Texas

The only exception to this rule will be for Hazardous Material applicants, where we will only accept one of the following:

- Commercial Driver's License issued by Texas
- Temporary Paper CDL issued by Texas

***All documents must be current and valid**
