

**Texas WIC Lesson Evaluation Results

Client Feedback

Total # of clients who responded to survey: 32

Clients surveyed identified themselves as:

- Pregnant: 15%
- Breastfeeding: 15%
- Caretaker of baby under 12 months: 32%
- Caretaker of a child over 1 year: 74%
- Friend of family: 33%
- First WIC class: 6%

Language in which the class was taught:

- English – 66%
- Spanish – 31%
- Both – 3%

Compared to other WIC classes, clients awarded this class **4.5 stars** (out of 5).

- The lesson was easy to follow


What staff would do differently the next time they teach the class:


- Clients do not always want to participate in the dancing



How many of the clients usually participate in the class discussion?


