# **Contract Infant Formula Update**

Effective October 1, 2020, Texas WIC vendors will notice changes to Abbott's Similac contract infant formula. Vendors do not need to take any action but be aware the new products will transition into their stock over the next six months.

## Changes include:

- Different label.
- Different size of can on some of its products.
- New nutrients and calorie amounts.

### No impact on WIC EBT transactions:

- Updated infant formula will not impact participants ability to shop.
- Current benefits on EBT cards will continue to scan.

### The following will remain the same:

- The infant formula UPCs and ounce amounts.
- Manufacturers and not-to-exceed (NTE) prices.
- Monthly food package benefit quantities.
