Vendor Policy Updates for WV: 02.0, 10.0, 11.0

Texas WIC has revised the following vendor policies:

- WV: 02.0 Least Expensive Brand (LEB) Declaration
- WV: 10.0 WIC Vendor Authorization
- WV: 11.0 WIC Vendor Reauthorization

WV: 02.0 - Least Expensive Brand Declaration

Section	Revisions - Effective November 1, 2021
Purpose	No changes
Authority	No changes
Policy	No changes
Procedure	 Removed the requirement to submit LEB declaration form during reauthorization LEB declaration form now only required during initial authorization and anytime thereafter if the LEBs change



WV: 10.0 - WIC Vendor Authorization

Section	Revisions - Effective September 28, 2021
Purpose	No changes
Authority	No changes
Policy	No changes
Procedure	 Updated the definition of Preauthorization Process Added "initial" authorization and removed "reauthorization" under Vendor Selection No longer require inventory invoices to check minimum stocking requirements during reauthorization Added language that during reauthorization the State Agency may request documentation

WV: 11.0 - WIC Vendor Reauthorization

Section	Revisions - Effective November 1, 2021
Purpose	No Changes
Authority	No Changes
Policy	More clear, concise languageChanged "shall" to "must"
Procedure	 The State Agency may review documents during reauthorization Differentiated how reauthorization is different from the initial authorization; however, vendor must maintain compliance with selection criteria while on the program
