## **Update: Food Flexibilities and Monitoring**

To support our WIC community, Texas WIC is extending the food flexibilities to help ensure access to WIC supplemental foods for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic. The food flexibilities will remain in place until 30 days after the end of the nationally declared COVID-19 public health emergency.

Please refer to the March 25, 2020, <u>Vendor News Flash</u> for a list of allowable COVID-19 flexibilities by food category. Vendors are encouraged to continue proper labeling and should utilize these flexibilities when prescribed food items are unavailable.

Routine monitoring in the stores will resume September 2021. In-store technical assistance, as needed, and on-site evaluations will resume in October 2021. Below is a list of monitoring and in-store activities and the status for each.
