1. Introduction

The *Report on the Mental Health First Aid Program for Fiscal Year 2023* is submitted in compliance with Health and Safety Code (HSC), Section 1001.205(b),¹ which requires the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to submit a report to the Legislature by December 1 of each year. The report includes:

- The number of local mental health authority (LMHA) and local behavioral health authority (LBHA) employees and contractors trained as Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) trainers during the preceding fiscal year, the number of trainers who left the program for any reason during the preceding fiscal year, and the number of active trainers;
- The number of higher education employees,² school district employees, and school resource officers who completed an MHFA training program provided by an authority during the preceding fiscal year categorized by LMHA and LBHA region, school district or institution of higher education, as applicable, and category of personnel;
- The number of people who are not higher education employees, school district employees, or school resource officers who completed an MHFA training program provided by an authority during the preceding fiscal year;
- The number of teenagers trained in teen MHFA by an authority during the preceding fiscal year;
- The number of service members, veterans, and immediate family members (SMVF) who completed the veterans' module of an MHFA training program provided by an authority during the preceding fiscal year; and
- A detailed accounting of expenditures of money appropriated for the purpose of implementing Subchapter H (Mental Health First Aid Training) of Chapter 1001 of the HSC.

MHFA is an evidence-based curriculum used to teach people how to help someone who may be developing a behavioral health problem or experiencing a behavioral health crisis. The goal of the MHFA program is to decrease stigma, increase awareness, and provide resources to people who might be experiencing a behavioral health crisis. HSC, Chapter 1001, Subchapter H, directs HHSC to provide grants to LMHAs and LBHAs, pursuant to HSC, Section 533.0356(a)(1), to train staff and contractors as MHFA instructors. MHFA instructors provide MHFA training to higher education employees, school district employees, and school resource officers at no cost to the trainees or their employers.

Beginning in fiscal year 2020, training is also provided to SMVF members, as required by statute.³

Texas Education Code, Section 8.152 (enacted by House Bill 19, 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019), requires LMHAs and LBHAs to employ a non-physician mental health professional (NPMHP) located at a regional education service center (ESC) to serve as a mental health and substance use resource for school districts located in the region. The NPMHP works directly with the MHFA outreach workers at each LMHA or LBHA, and in doing so, has increased both entities' awareness of each other, increased MHFA training opportunities, made mental health resources available to the school districts, and helped create a partnership between the LMHAs and LBHAs and the public educational system.

2. Background

Since the inception of MHFA, LMHAs and LBHAs have increasingly trained more Texans each year. The number of people projected to be trained in MHFA in fiscal year 2020 was on track to surpass previous years; however, training decreased in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Prior to COVID-19, MHFA training was solely offered in-person. Due to the inability to hold in-person classes throughout the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the National Council for Mental Wellbeing, which owns the national MHFA curriculum, developed virtual MHFA courses. The virtual adult and youth MHFA courses became available in June 2020, and MHFA instructors were trained to use the virtual platform. Training opportunities and the number of people trained in MHFA increased in 2021 and surpassed pre-pandemic numbers in 2022 and 2023, but many challenges remain. The LMHAs and LBHAs continue to work together regionally and statewide to address these barriers.

Many schools continue to experience staff and substitute teacher shortages, which makes it difficult for educators and other school staff to attend MHFA trainings. Additionally, educators have competing training priorities. Schools have also become more selective regarding who is allowed on campus as they work to implement new school safety plans. MHFA trainings are offered on professional development days, evenings, overnights, and weekends to try to address these barriers. MHFA trainings are also offered at regional ESCs so that any school staff may attend even if the training is not offered at their campus.

Several distinct MHFA modules are available, including the veterans' module. The veterans' module was only offered in-person with an older curriculum until 2023. The veterans' module has been updated to a newer curriculum but continues to only be offered in-person at this time. Since the LMHAs and LBHAs train on the updated MHFA curriculum, the veterans' module training was not offered for several months in fiscal year 2023. General adult and youth classes were available in the interim and continue to be offered virtually. Although SMVF are being made aware of MHFA training, to date there has been limited success engaging this population to register for training. At the LMHAs and LBHAs, the MHFA staff and the Veteran Peer Service Coordinator collaborate to better connect with SMVF. Additionally, HHSC and the Texas Veterans Commission host quarterly calls with LMHA and LBHA staff to discuss successes, barriers, and strategies for reaching this population.

3. Mental Health First Aid Data

This section contains MHFA training data and expenditures for fiscal year 2023. HHSC collected data from LMHAs and LBHAs through annual reports, monthly invoices, and an online data collection system.

LMHA and LBHA Employees and Contractors Trained

Table 1 below shows the total number of active trainers at each LMHA or LBHA as of August 2023, the average number of active trainers at each LMHA or LBHA throughout fiscal year 2023, and the total number of trainers who left the program at each LMHA or LBHA during fiscal year 2023.



MHFA Training for Instructors, School District Employees, Higher Education Employees, Community Members, and Teenagers

Figure 1 shows the total number of instructors, school district employees, higher education employees, community members,⁴ and teenagers⁵ who were trained in fiscal year 2023.

Accounting of Expenditures

Table 2 contains the aggregate number of people trained in MHFA followed by total state funds expended by all 39 LMHAs and LBHAs. Expenses were captured monthly through invoices submitted by LMHAs and LBHAs. At times, LMHAs and LBHAs train together, and funds are shared among LMHAs and LBHAs as needed to fund trainings. This initiative is funded through state general revenue, as well as through the federal Mental Health Block Grant.

4. Conclusion

All 39 LMHAs and LBHAs continued to participate in the MHFA program during fiscal year 2023. Each of the LMHAs and LBHAs submitted an annual plan to the MHFA program outlining how the LMHAs and LBHAs would develop and maintain community partnerships and increase training opportunities in their service areas.

At the end of fiscal year 2023:

- 527 LMHA and LBHA employees and contractors were active MHFA trainers;
- 13 was the average number of active trainers at each LMHA and LBHA; and
- 70 MHFA trainers left the program.

In fiscal year 2023, the MHFA program and statewide partnerships resulted in 33,346 people trained in 2023:

- 168 LMHA and LBHA employees and contractors trained as new MHFA instructors;
- 16,624 higher education employees, public school district employees, and school resource officers trained in MHFA;
- 15,295 people from the community who were not higher education employees or a public school district trained in MHFA;
- 1,259 teenagers trained in teen MHFA; and
- 6,454 service members, veterans, and their immediate family members trained in MHFA.⁶

HHSC anticipates that MHFA training will continue to increase in upcoming years as more people become aware of the training available to them and opportunities to attend a training. With the passing of House Bill 2059, 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, more people may be trained with state funding starting in September 2023. As a result, it is expected that the number of people trained will increase in fiscal year 2024 and beyond.
