

2021 Lifeguard Your Child Campaign Highlights

Awareness	65,086 Water Watcher Tags distributed as a tool to remind adults to provide in-reach supervision without distraction during swim time. Offering sustainable messages and prevention tools in targeted locations is key. For example, 425 Cook Children's loaner life jackets were stocked onto 22 loaner stations, across 5 counties.	
Education	3,877 parents and 8,635 children were educated by partners using water safety toolkits. 72% of children were 0-4 years (Most At-Risk). This level of education resulted in 1,349 children enrolling in Cook Children's Water Safety Club with access to safety resources all year 'round.	
Layers of Protection	Through Collaborative efforts, 522 children completed free water safety lessons led by Safe Kids North Texas Coalition members. 617 life jackets were distributed directly to families by partners. 186 families have redeemed other safety incentives aligned with best practice "Layers of Protection."	
Cook Children's Media Report	15.7M via social media, 1.6M video views, and 12.3M impressions through paid digital media.	
Cook Children's Loaner Station	Loaner life jacket stations offer a stand-alone, sustainable message at lake entry points; at-risk areas for drownings. The overa design, completed in 2019, transitioned to building 14 stations for lakes across 5 counties.	
Educational Collateral	15,150 <i>Stewie the Duck</i> and <i>Clifford Takes a Swim</i> books were distributed in support of best practices around water. These water safety safety books are intended to reinforce water safety after an initial educational event.	









2021 Lifeguard Your Child Goals

Cook Children's supported our partners' ability to better record their LYC campaign efforts by funding a shared database. This gave partners a user-friendly app to report their work, enabling improved trackability with regard to the reach of the campaign.

WW Tags are an injury prevention tool, created as a reminder for adults to stay in-reach of children without distraction while guarding swimmers in the water.				
4. Update and enforce pool ordinances	 Due to shut downs during COVID-19: partner city is reviewing pool ordinances* partner city may consider revising pool ordinances* The Spectrum of Prevention considers ordinances as a high level strategy toward greater impact. Recently, discussions began in Fort Worth that may lead to updates to improve home occupation ordinances/backyard swim lessons in residential areas.				
5. Create a planning committee to strengthen city efforts	17 planning committees paused due to COVID-19* Collaborative efforts by a group are crucial when creating lasting change within a community. Committees are a core component of establishing plans and designating strategies that may affect outcomes and increase exposure. City of Burleson drowning prevention committee works with local partners to create water safety mascots, videos, school & event outreach, as well as swim lessons, and a new pilot loaner station for pools in partnership with Cook Children's.




