### SP3 Background



### Statutory Direction for SP3

- Texas Government Code (TGC), Chapter 534, Subchapter C requires the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to develop and implement a pilot program through the STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care program to test personcentered managed care strategies and improvements under a capitated model.
- The statute requires HHSC to coordinate and collaborate with the STAR+PLUS Pilot Program Workgroup (SP3W) and Intellectual and Developmental Disability System Redesign Advisory Committee (IDD SRAC).



### SP3 Purpose

- Test the delivery of long-term services and supports (LTSS) for adults in STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care with:
  - Intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD)
    - Excludes people currently enrolled in an IDD 1915(c) waiver or a community-based intermediate care facility for individuals with an intellectual disability (ICF/IID)
  - Traumatic brain injury (TBI) that occurred after the age of 21
  - People with similar functional needs without regard to age of onset or diagnosis

### SP3 Purpose (cont.)

 Evaluate the SP3 and inform the plan to transition all or a portion of services provided through IDD waiver and ICF/IID programs into managed care





#### **SP3 Evaluation**

#### Comprehensive analysis due by Sept. 1, 2026

- Analyze the experiences and outcomes of changes
- Include feedback on the pilot based on personal experiences of pilot participants, families, and providers
- Include recommendations on:
  - Programs and services for consideration by the legislature;
  - Necessary statutory changes; and
  - Whether to implement the pilot statewide under STAR+PLUS for eligible members



#### Service Area

### SP3 will operate in one of the following managed care service areas:

- Bexar Managed Care Service Area which includes Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina and Wilson counties.
- Tarrant Managed Care Service Area includes Denton, Hood, Johnson, Parker, Tarrant and Wise counties.




#### Service Area (cont.)

### SP3 will operate in one of the following managed care service areas:

 Medicaid Rural Service Area Northeast includes Montague, Cooke, Grayson, Fannin, Lamar, Delta, Red River, Bowie, Hopkins, Franklin, Titus, Morris, Cass, Rains, Wood, Camp, Upshur, Marion, Henderson, Smith, Gregg, Harrison, Anderson, Cherokee, Rusk, Panola, Houston, Nacogdoches, Shelby, Trinity, Angelina, San Augustine and Sabine counties.

### SP3 Opt Out

#### TGC, Section 534.1065(a) requires:

- An individual who is eligible for the SP3 be enrolled automatically, and the decision whether to opt out of participation in the SP3 and not receive LTSS under the SP3 may be made only by the individual or the individual's legally authorized representative (LARs).
- HHSC is planning to use the Enrollment Broker 1-800 number for eligible individuals or their LARs to opt out of SP3.
  - This process would be included in the enrollment packets and outreach and education materials.



### SP3 Opt Out (cont.)

### Timing of SP3 enrollment packets and outreach and education:

- SP3 enrollment packets will be mailed out six months prior to the SP3 operational start date and then each month through February 2024.
- Education and outreach will begin after SP3
   Managed Care Organization (MCO) notice of award.

### **Federal Authority**

- In response to the statutory direction for SP3 and communications with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid (CMS), HHSC is pursuing an 1115 waiver amendment using the parameters similar to the 1915(i) authority.
- Parameters of the 1915(i) authority to be included in the 1115 waiver amendment include:
  - Needs-based eligibility criteria and target group(s) that are less stringent than criteria to meet an institutional level of care
  - Quality measure reporting similar to 1915(c) waivers
  - Financial eligibility is 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL).



### Federal Authority (cont.)

- HHSC received direction from CMS on requirements for STAR+PLUS Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Medical Assistance Only (MAO) members.
- HHSC considered the impacts of two options identified by CMS:
  - Create a new eligibility group for STAR+PLUS HCBS MAO members; or
  - Exclude STAR+PLUS HCBS MAO members from SP3.
- HHSC will be excluding STAR+PLUS HCBS MAO members from SP3.



### Federal Authority (Cont.)

#### **HHSC** considered:

- Statutory requirements for SP3 eligibility requirements;
- Past eligibility recommendations from the IDD SRAC and SP3W;
- The overall number of STAR+PLUS HCBS MAOs and supplemental security income (SSI) recipients eligible for SP3;
- Impacts to systems changes, budget and timelines to create a new eligibility group;
- STAR+PLUS HCBS interest list impacts;
- · 1115 waiver amendment timelines; and
- SP3 evaluation impacts.

The selected vendor will be required to have demonstrated experience:

- Implementing interRAI Assessment Tool software,
- Training users how to use the software, and
- Training users how to administer the interRAI ID and Collaborative Action Plan (CAP) tools, including how to use the results and case mix system in SP3 service planning.

The selected vendor will be required to consult with clinical experts on interRAI ID, CAP, and person-centered planning practices and provide training and ongoing support on the software and assessment tools to HHSC and MCO staff. 28



- Current SP3 topics include:
  - Outreach and education development for potential participants and providers
  - Continue operationalizing enrollment and disenrollment processes
  - Alternate payment methodologies
  - Pilot evaluation
  - Service delivery models
  - Regulatory approach



### Next Steps (cont.)

- Finalize rates and service array
- Continue program and IT contract solicitation process
- Continue meeting with CMS to address outstanding pilot questions requiring federal guidance
- Draft federal authority agreements
- Continue working with IT/systems for systems modifications for TMHP, TIERS, and eligibility support technologies
- Finalize funding needed to operate the pilot services, staff to support pilot operation, and ongoing system maintenance.
