To Texans interested in improving services for families of children who have a disability:

The Texas Health and Human Services Commission is accepting applications for membership on the Policy Council for Children and Families. The council works to improve the coordination, quality, efficiency and outcomes of services provided to children with disabilities and their families through the state's health, education and human services systems.

The HHS executive commissioner will appoint members to the council to serve a term expiring Dec. 31, 2027 or Dec. 31, 2028. Currently, HHSC is seeking representatives to be selected from the following categories:

- Member of a family of a child 25 or younger with mental health care needs
- Member of a family of a child 25 or younger with a disability
- Member of a family of a child 25 or younger with autism spectrum disorder
- Youth representative 25 or younger with a disability receiving services from an HHS agency
- Person with expertise providing mental health services to children with disabilities
- Physician providing services to children with complex needs
- Organization or person who advocates or provides services or resources to children and the families of children with autism spectrum disorder

A council member must regularly take part in council meetings and may also have to take part in subcommittee meetings, projects and presentations. Council meetings will be held in Austin about once every three months or at the call of the presiding officer. To the extent permitted by the current state budget, a council member who receives services from HHSC or is a family member of a child who receives services may be repaid for their travel expenses to and from meetings if money is available and in accordance with the HHSC Travel Policy. Other council members aren't paid to attend or travel to and from council meetings.
