### 1.0 Subject and Purpose

The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) Long-Term Care Regulatory (LTCR) department is retiring certain provider letters (PLs) issued eight or more years ago, as explained in [PL 17-08](#) dated April 7, 2017. LTCR is also retiring several DAHS PLs issued less than eight years ago because they are no longer needed. This PL is to notify you the PLs listed below are retired and are no longer available on the HHSC website. A DAHS should not rely on the information in these PLs.

As noted in PL 17-08, retirement of a PL does not affect the applicability or enforceability of current statutes and rules. A DAHS remains obligated to comply with all applicable state and federal statutes and rules, including those related to a topic covered in a retired PL.
