Medicaid Health Care Services:

All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:

- Doctor and clinic visits
- 24-hour emergency care
- Hospital care
- Surgery
- Ambulance service
- Lab and X-ray services
- Major organ transplants
- Hearing tests and aids
- Home health services
- Community First Choice
- Personal Care Services
- Podiatrists (foot doctors)
- Help for drug or alcohol problems
- Dialysis for kidney problems
- Family planning services
- Eye checkups, glasses, and contact lenses
- Shots
- Texas Health Steps medical and dental checkups
- No limit on medicines Mental health services (such as counseling)
- Chiropractors (neck and back doctors)
- Private Duty Nursing

People on the MDCP waiver can receive the following services:

- Adaptive aids
- Minor home modifications
- Transition assistance services
- Employment assistance
- Flexible family support services
- Financial management services
- Respite services
- Supported employment

Extra Help Getting a Ride	Transportation services at no cost for members to Texas Children's Health Plan sponsored classes or qualifying events.	Rides to appointments not covered by Medicaid. For example, equine therapy.
Disease Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$25 reward card for members ages 18 and up who have type 1 or type 2 diabetes and complete a diabetic (retinal or dilated) eye exam once per year. • \$50 reward card for members ages 10 and up who have type 1 or type 2 diabetes and complete an HbA1c blood test every 6 months. 	
Extra Vision Services	\$110 allowance towards upgrades for frames and lenses or \$90 towards contacts and contact fittings for members up to 18 years old.	Up to \$105 maximum eyewear allowance towards upgrades for frames, lenses, or contacts every 24 months that aren't covered by the Medicaid benefit.
Sports and School Physicals	A yearly sports and school physical exam at no cost for school or camp entrance for members ages 5 to 19, performed by their PCP.	1 each year for Members 4 to 20 years of age.
Help for Members with Asthma		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allergy-free mattress cover and pillowcase for members under active case management with asthma or COPD. • Roach repellant wall plugs for members who are under case management for Asthma or COPD.
Extra Help for Pregnant Women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portable Crib/Playpen: A portable crib that doubles as a playpen at no cost for members that notify Texas Children's Health Plan within 14 days of the birth of their child. • Basic Baby Care and Birth Classes: Online classes through INJOY at no cost for pregnant members to learn about pregnancy, childbirth, breastfeeding, postpartum health, newborn care, and more. Printed materials are available upon request. • Prenatal Visit Reward: \$25 reward card for pregnant members who complete at least one prenatal visit during their pregnancy. • Postpartum Visit Reward: \$25 reward card for members who complete at least one postpartum visit within 42 days after giving birth. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Infant care book for pregnant members. • Join Babyscripts to receive access to free educational content, resources, and more. Eligible pregnant members also receive rewards for completing the enrollment, a prenatal visit, and a post-partum visit.

Resource book for families of adoptive children (only available in English). Sensory goods for eligible members with sensory sensitivity. A pack of food allergy labels.
