All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:

- Doctor and clinic visits
- 24-hour emergency care
- Hospital care
- Surgery
- Ambulance service

- Major organ transplants
- Hearing tests and aids
- Home health services
- Community First Choice
- Personal Care Services
- Podiatrists (foot doctors)
- Help for drug or alcohol problems
- Dialysis for kidney problems
- Family planning services
- Eye checkups, glasses, and contact lenses
- Shots
- Texas Health Steps medical and dental checkups
- No limit on medicines Mental health services (such as counseling)
- Chiropractors (neck and back doctors)
- Private Duty Nursing

Members ages 18 to 21 that attend one checkup per year are eligible to receive a \$25 reward card. • Health Education Special Events: In-person and virtual seasonal activities and community events are offered exclusively for members. • Educational Achievement Program: Members between the school grades 9 and 12 are eligible for a \$25 reward card per semester for the following achievements by the end of the school year (limit 2 reward cards per school year): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A GPA of 3.5 or greater ○ Attendance record of 95% or higher • GED Reward Card: Members ages 17 and up are eligible to a reward card upon completion of a GED.
