Medicaid Health Care Services:

All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:

- Doctor and clinic visits
- 24-hour emergency care
- Hospital care
- Surgery
- Ambulance service

- Major organ transplants
- Hearing tests and aids
- Home health services
- Community First Choice
- Personal Care Services
- Podiatrists (foot doctors)

- Eye checkups, glasses, and contact lenses
- Shots
- Texas Health Steps medical and dental checkups
- No limit on medicines Mental health services (such as counseling)

Extra Help Getting a Ride	Members can get free rides to approved services not covered by Medicaid such as non-emergency doctor visits, therapy, pharmacy, WIC visits, BCBSTX member events and meetings, hippotherapy, approved health classes or for covered services where the parent needs to bring more than one child.	
Disease Management	Members who join the Special Beginnings program will have access to breastfeeding support information provided by Special Beginnings nurses.	
Extra Vision Services	Members 18 and younger can get upgrades to their eyewear every year, up to \$150.	\$100 allowance for upgrades to frames, lenses or contacts, once every two years, in addition to the standard Medicaid benefit.
Discount Pharmacy / Over-the-Counter Benefits	All members get a free membership to Blue365, a program which offers discounts for health and wellness products and services	Up to \$30 allowance for over-the-counter items mailed to your home every quarter. The OTC catalog includes household, personal care, oral care and children's items. No prescription required.
Sports and School Physicals	1 free sports or school physical each year for members.	One sports physical each year for members ages 4 to 18 Years.
Help for Members with Asthma		Allergy-free mattress cover and pillowcase to help control asthma symptoms when enrolled in Superior's asthma care management program

Healthy Play and Exercise Programs	Members can receive up to \$100 reimbursed for summer camp enrollment fees.	Up to \$150 for the cost of attending a camp of member's choice. Camp must be approved by the Service Coordination Department 90 days prior to the camp start date. Allowance will be paid directly to the camp provider.
