Medicaid Health Care Services:

All children and young adults age 20 and younger in managed care receive the same traditional Medicaid services. Some of those services are things such as:

Extra Help Getting a Ride (when state services are not available)	Members can get free rides to non-emergency doctor visits, therapy, pharmacy, WIC visits, BCBSTX member events and meetings, and approved health classes.	
Disease Management		Up to \$500 towards nursing facility stay expenses. Members must participate in the Money Follows the Person (MFP) process for Medically Dependent Children Program (MDCP).
Extra Vision Services	\$150 allowance for members ages 0-18 toward upgrade to eyewear upgraded lenses, contact lenses or an additional pair of glasses yearly after an eye exam.	\$150 allowance for select eyeglass lenses, frames, or contact lenses that are not covered by Medicaid once every two years.
Drug Store Services/Over-the-Counter Benefits	All members get a free membership to Blue365, a program which offers discounts for health and wellness products and services.	Up to \$30 allowance per quarter for over-the-counter items. The OTC catalog includes household, personal care, and oral care items. No prescription required.
Sports and School Physicals	Members can get 1 free sports and camp physical each year.	One sports/school physical each year for members 4 to 18 years old.
Help for Members with Asthma	Members who fill a prescription for an asthma medication for four months in a row are eligible to receive one (1) \$25 gift card per calendar year.	Allergy-free mattress cover and pillowcase to help control asthma symptoms when enrolled in Asthma Disease Management for 60 continuous days.
Extra Help for Pregnant Women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members who join the Special Beginnings program will have access to breastfeeding education information provided by Special Beginnings nurses. • Members can get a car seat or pack n play by enrolling in Special Beginnings and going to a prenatal visit in the first trimester or within 42 days of plan enrollment. • Upon completion of online prenatal.
