Dental Services	Dental kit to keep teeth clean and healthy for members 21 and older.	Up to \$500 annually towards two routine exams/cleanings, a set of x-rays and one scaling/root planning, if medically necessary for Members ages 21 & older. Other services given at a discount.
Extra Vision Services	Certain plastic lenses above the basic benefit for members 21 and older.	Up to \$105 maximum eyewear allowance towards upgrades for frames, lenses, or contacts every 24 months that aren't covered by the Medicaid benefit.
Temporary Phone Help	Members who qualify for the federal lifeline program can get a free cell phone with monthly minutes, text messages and data through the federal lifeline provider. Wellpoint members can get unlimited calls to member services, member advocates and service coordinators through our toll-free line and health text messages, including important renewal reminders. Additional 100 bonus minutes during member's birth month and one-time 200 bonus minutes at enrollment.

First aid kit and personal disaster plan online to all members. Personalized labels to identify personal belongings including clothing, shoes and personal items once every 2 years. 	 Active members will receive a welcome kit upon admission to an in-network facility. Receive adult activity books: word search, crossword puzzle, Sudoku, coloring book, paid postage postcards, and colored pencils. Personal blanket for lap or bed. Bonsai kit available for members in a nursing facility (as allowed) for stress relief and mental engagement. Preprinted member name waterproof clothing labels.
