IMPORTANT: Electronic submission is required. Each document must be sent as an individual file **with your name at the end of the file name** attached to a single email when possible. Failure to follow the instructions will result in points being deducted from your ranking score. Please send any questions you might have to the email address above.

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Admissions Requirements

Admission to the Medical Laboratory Science program is competitive and limited to four students per year.

The program accepts applications through the Monday after Thanksgiving week. Interviews will be held in January. The program start date is September 1^{st} . Early application is encouraged.

Applicants are considered for admission based on

- MLS major from affiliated university (3+1) **OR** baccalaureate degree (4+1) degree from an accredited university. All foreign degrees must be evaluated by one of the providers found at the end of this document.
- Overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Science GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Essay written according to the formatting requirements provided.
- Two completed reference forms
- Personal interview.
- Submission of a resume.
- Foreign students current F1 or work Visa or green card.

Academic Admissions Requirements

To be considered for admission into the Austin State Hospital Medical Laboratory Science program prospective students must have completed, or will complete prior to the start of the program, the following coursework with a grade of "C minus" or higher:

- 1. Sixteen (24 quarter) hours of biology which must include one semester in each of the following courses:
 - a. Microbiology
 - b. Immunology
 - c. Human Anatomy and/or Physiology
 - d. Genetics and/or Molecular Biology
- 2. Sixteen (24 quarter) hours of chemistry with one semester in organic or biochemistry
- 3. Statistics or Biostatics

Selection Process

- 1. Applicants are awarded points for each of the following:
 - a. Application properly completed.
 - b. GPA, both overall and science.
 - c. Written essay.
 - d. References minimum of two required.
 - e. Personal interview

2. The points are added up and the top applicants will be interviewed. **NOTE:** Not all qualified applicants will receive interviews.

Upon completion of the selection process four applicants and two alternates will be selected for the class.

Instructions for Completing the Application Packet ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION IS REQUIRED

Please complete and submit the MLS application and all other required documents to <u>ASHMLSProgram@hhsc.state.tx.us.</u> Please type the required information into the application. Use an electronic signature or type your name into the signature box.

IMPORTANT: Save each document to be submitted **WITH YOUR NAME AT THE END OF THE FILE NAME.**

Required Documents to Complete Your Packet:

- Austin State Hospital Medical Laboratory Science Program application which includes signing acknowledgement of Essential Functions for Medical Laboratory Sciences.
- 2. State of Texas Application. This is required because, if accepted, you will become a Texas state employee with full benefits including health insurance.
- 3. Reference form from two individuals. These individuals must be faculty or professional references such as supervisors or managers. Note: You will send the form electronically to your references. The completed form must be emailed to the program from the individual completing the form using their work email address.
- 4. Essay of Interest in Medical Laboratory Science written in accordance with the instructions provided on the next page.
- 5. GPA Calculator Fill in all coursework for calculation of the overall GPA. Copy/paste science courses into the science GPA calculator.
- 6. Resume
- 7. For 3+1 MLS degree candidates you must have your academic advisor submit a letter: The academic advisor letter will state that the applicant the student is in good academic standing and is on track for degree completion. Degree candidates for other majors must submit a letter from the advisor stating anticipated graduation before the start date of the Medical Laboratory Science training program.
- 8. Attach each document in a single email and sent to to the ASHMLSProgram@hhsc.state.tx.u. Do not combine documents into one file. Include each document separately in one email.
- 9. Transcripts

- a. Current official transcripts emailed directly from the registrar's office <u>from all</u> <u>colleges and universities attended</u> to: <u>ashmlsprogram@hhsc.state.tx.us</u>.

Essay Instructions

READ CAREFULLY! The essay will be graded based on the following criteria:

- 1. **Length -** Minimum of one page, no more than 3 pages long. <u>Cover page does not</u> count.
- 2. Cover page (each of the following on a separate line, centered):
 - a. Austin State Hospital
 - b. Medical Laboratory Science Program
 - c. Essay of Interest
 - d. Your Name

3. Formatting as follows:

- a. Double spaced.
- b. Twelve-point font, Times New Roman
- c. One-inch margins
- 4. **Structure** Appropriate spelling, grammar and punctuation.
- 5. **Composition -** theme, flow and expression of thought processes.
- 6. The narrative must focus on your reasons for pursuing a degree as an MLS and MUST ADDRESS EACH of the following, a-h:
 - a. Introduction:
 - i. Provide the reasons why you are pursuing a career as a medical laboratory scientist.
 - ii. Describe work experience, if any, which you have had in a clinical, research, or non-medical laboratory. If you do not have any experience state that in your narrative.
 - iii. Experiences in any health care field or in your life which directly relates to your knowledge of and interest in medical laboratory science.
 - b. List the personal strengths which will allow you to successfully complete the program and function effectively as a MLS upon graduation.
 - c. Describe how you are able to adapt to unexpected situations or changes.
 - d. List the challenges which may interfere in your education and plans you have to work around them.
 - e. What are your plans for using your MLS degree or certificate? Will you practice as an MLS? If so for how long? Do you immediately wish to use this to prepare you for an advanced degree? If so in what area?
 - f. Closing paragraph describing why you should be accepted into the program.
