Getting Ready for Quality Reporting

What's the same in SFY2024?

- If you enrolled in DPP BHS for SFY2024 (the third program year), you must report specific quality measures as a condition of participation. There is no pay-for-performance in SFY2024.
- The reporting timeline and process will be like SFY2023 quality reporting, with two required rounds of reporting and one correction period. You will complete an Excel-based reporting template and upload it to the online reporting portal.
- HHSC will review each round of reporting to ensure that you are meeting the program's conditions of participation and to identify any issues with the quality or accuracy of your reported data.
- Directed payment programs must be [evaluated](#) to show that the payment arrangement is advancing the goals of the Texas Managed Care Quality Strategy.

What's new in SFY2024?

- Some measures were removed, new measures were added, and some specifications changed. If you reported a measure for the SFY2023 program, you may need to adjust your reporting logic to report that same measure in SFY2024. The measure comparison tables in this document shows these changes.
- Some measures have numeric targets that will be used to measure improvement over time. Your performance in 2023 will help determine if the program is advancing the quality goals and objectives in the [evaluation plan](#).
- HHSC will host a series of virtual meetings called Measure Spotlights. These meetings will focus on one or two DPP quality measures. HHSC staff will provide an overview of the measure, measure specifications, and performance to date. You can ask questions about the featured measure and discuss strategies for quality improvement. Invitations will be sent to the DPP Quality contact list.
