HHSC reviews each reporting round



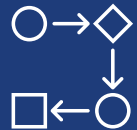

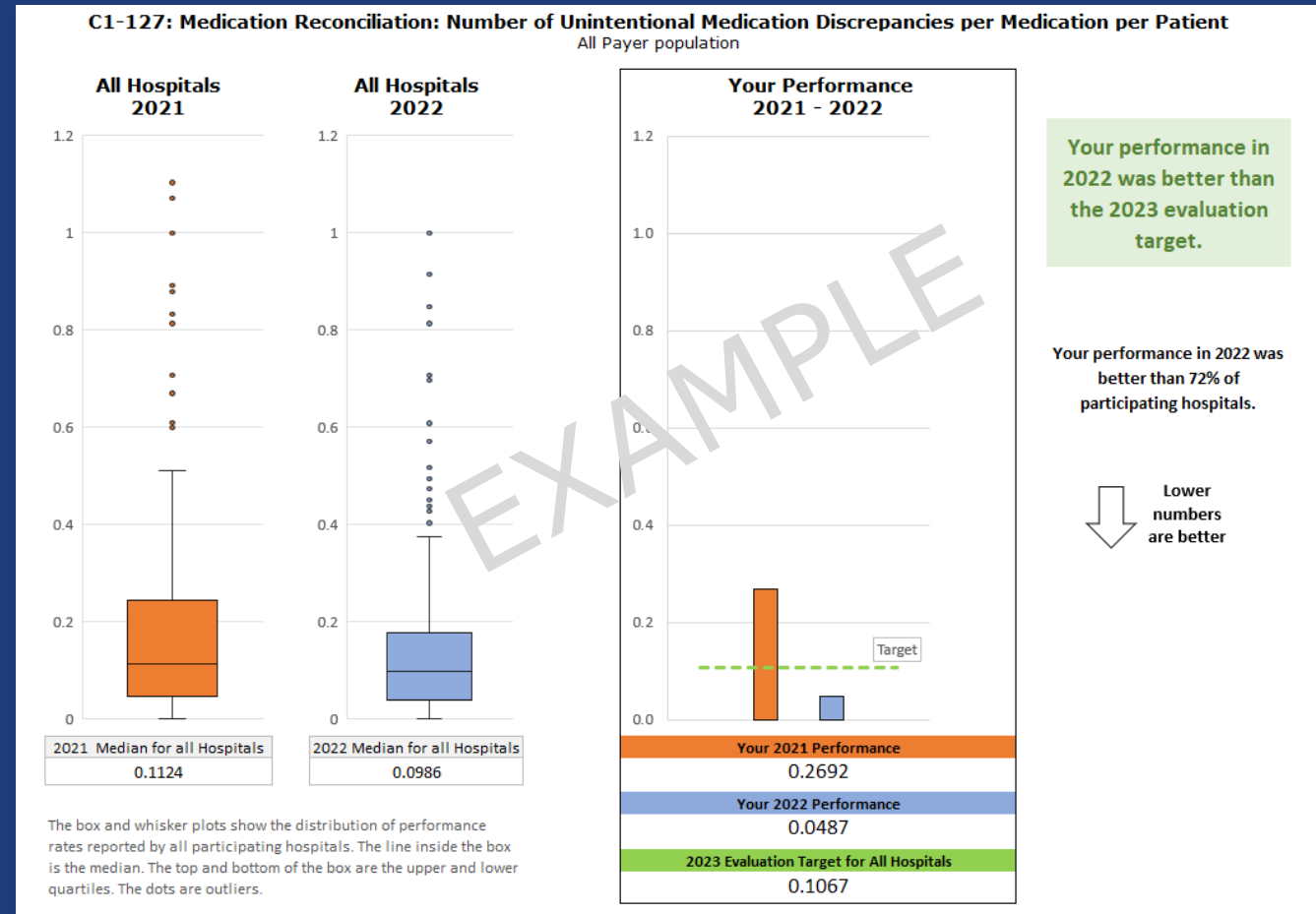
