SUBJECT: Texas WIC Policy GA:8.0 - Provision of Information to WIC Applicants and Participants About Other Health-related and Public Assistance Programs

The state agency is in the process of updating Texas WIC Policy GA:8.0 – *Provision of Information to WIC Applicants and Participants About Other Health-related and Public Assistance Programs*. During this revision process, local agencies will not be required to provide paper applications for the Healthy Texas Women program to initial applicants, as is stated in current policy. LAs must continue to provide the Guide to Helpful Programs and Services at each initial certification. This must also be provided at subsequent certifications or posted in a public location.
