Why We Need to Keep Consumers in The Kitchen: Optimizing Healthy Habits Post COVID Presented by Joan Salge Blake, EdD, RDN, LDN, FAND



Homemade meals tend to contain more heart-healthy fruits and veggies and less heart-unhealthy saturated fat, sodium, and excess calories. With over 70 percent Americans considered to be overweight, increasing their risk for heart disease, certain cancers, stroke, and diabetes, curtailing the dining out experience and eating more meals at home is good for the consumer's overall health. BUT, while the desire to cook meals at home has increased, research also shows the need for cutting back on the amount of time preparing these meals has also increased. Being dubbed as "COVID Cooking Fatigue," the consumer is looking for tasty meal options that don't necessarily involve a lot of slicing and dicing.

This presentation will provide science-based information on the consumers' current eating trends and empower staff with tips and strategies to help the public when it comes to sustaining healthy eating habits inside the home.
