Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for a vendor convicted of selling firearms, ammunition, explosives, or controlled substances in exchange for food instruments, from \$15,487 to \$16,451 per violation.• Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for a vendor convicted of trafficking in food instruments from \$15,877 to \$16,865 per violation.• Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for all violations identified in a single investigation from \$63,509 to \$67,461.
