WV: 1.0 - WIC Vendor Agreement/Policy Violations

Section	Revisions - Effective April 1, 2022
Purpose	No changes

Procedure	 Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for a vendor convicted of selling firearms, ammunition, explosives, or controlled substances in exchange for food instruments, from \$15,487 to \$16,451 per violation. Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for a vendor convicted of trafficking in food instruments from \$15,877 to \$16,865 per violation. Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for all violations identified in a single investigation from \$63,509 to \$67,461.
