Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for a vendor convicted of selling firearms, ammunition, explosives, or controlled substances in exchange for food instruments, from \$16,451 to \$17,725 per violation. • Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for a vendor convicted of trafficking in food instruments from \$16,865 to \$18,171 per violation. • Increased the maximum Civil Money Penalty (CMP) for all violations identified in a single investigation from \$67,461 to \$72,686.
