Recall of Select Units of Lactaid® Milk

Some 96 oz. Lactaid items have been recalled because they may contain trace amounts of almond, which is not listed on the label. This could be dangerous for families with almond allergies. This recall affects only some 96 oz. containers (big plastic jug), not the more popular half gallon containers. The UPC, product codes and Best By Dates are listed in the [Lactaid recall notice](#).

The recall notice advises people who have purchased affected items to return them to the retail location where the purchase was made for a full refund or exchange or call Hood Consumer Affairs at 800-242-2423. This applies to customers who purchased with WIC benefits, cash, SNAP, etc. As a reminder, WIC clients have the same rights as all other consumers under this recall and should be treated like all other customers. You are not required to determine whether a product was purchased with WIC benefits as a part of the exchange process.
