## **Vendor News Flash**

### **Recall of Nutramigen Hypoallergenic Infant Formula Powder**

Reckitt/Mead Johnson has issued a voluntary recall for specific lots of Nutramigen Hypoallergenic Infancy Formula LGG Powder in 12.6 and 19.8 oz.

WIC clients who have Nutramigen Hypoallergenic Infant Formula Powder with the batch codes below should stop using it and contact Reckitt/Mead Johnson Nutrition for guidance:

- ZL3FHG (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FMH (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FPE (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FQD (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FRW (19.8 oz cans)
- ZL3FXJ (12.6 oz cans)

The products have a UPC Code of 300871239418 or 300871239456 and "Use By Date" of 01 Jan 2025.

As a reminder, WIC clients have the same rights as all other consumers under this recall and should be treated like all other customers. You are not required to determine whether a product was purchased with WIC benefits as a part of the exchange process.

Vendors should follow Reckitt /Mead Johnson's instructions on the recall. Please keep in mind that the reconciliation of cost for the formula is between the grocery store and Reckitt /Mead Johnson.

If clients are having difficulty finding Nutramigen LGG powder that is not impacted by the recall, please direct them to contact their WIC clinic for options. The WIC clinic may be able to change to Nutramigen concentrate or Nutramigen ready to feed if it is available. If a change to the brand is needed, the WIC staff will need to coordinate with the healthcare provider.
